 Lector / Reader

Proclaims Word of God at Mass; about once a month.

 Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist

Distributes Eucharist at Mass; about once a month.

 Extraordinary Minister to the Sick/Shut In

Bringing communion to shut-ins or the sick, periodically or every First Friday of each month.

 Usher

Help direct parishioners to pews, collection.

 Altar Servers (Adults/children – Male/Female)

For children grade 3 and up. Scheduled once a month, may also serve at weddings, funerals and various special liturgies.

 Choir / Cantor

Join and sing with one of the choirs at the Saturday evening Mass or Sunday morning Mass. Cantoring for special liturgies, weddings, funerals, etc.

 Instrumentalist (_____)

Join and play with one of the choirs at the Saturday evening Mass or Sunday morning Mass. Also providing music to special liturgies, weddings, funerals, etc.

 Children's Liturgy (Sunday Mass 10:00am) (___ Leader) (___ Assistant) (___ Student helper)

Proclaiming the Word of God in children's terms about once a month. No preparation necessary, lessons are provided

 Volunteer at fund-raising events or Special Projects

To plan social events, promote community within the parish and raise funds for parish needs. Volunteers are needed to sell tickets, set up and clean up, etc.

 St. Vincent de Paul Society, St. Ann's Conference

Provides assistance to those in our community in need. Home visits and periodic meetings. Assistance with Christmas Hamper drive / program.

 Hospitality / Social Sunday

Provide refreshments and cookies at our Hospitality / Social Sundays which take place following each Mass every third Sunday of the month.
